- 1) Bank account at ~\$70k – doesn't include October \$3,500 donation to Parish.
- 2) Krejci – Brent working on bids for improving parking lot.
- 3) Quick review of monthly expenses for awareness
 - a. \$3,500 donation to the Parish
 - b. ~\$100 per month to Parish for share of MUD bill
 - c. ~\$100 per month to Parish for share of OPPD bill
 - d. ~\$1,450 per month for Soccer Field mowing/maintenance (averaged across 12 months)
 - e. Total = \$5,150 per month

Other Topics

- Soccer Field Parking Lot Bids (Todd Beran)
 - o Reached out to various external businesses for bids with approximately \$15k for materials/crushed rock on the parking lot with a cap/target of \$20k on project.
 - o Projected date of completion would be before snow fall this year.
 - o Will look for a vote in coming meetings.
- HUDL cameras for sports teams (JR Ritter)
 - o Looking for more details on pricing.
- Parent behavior – Need to send out communication on parent expectations.
 - o If parents have concerns or issues with coaches, coaching, playing time, etc.,
 - No discussion until 24+ hours after the competition.
 - No discussion in front of student athletes.
 - Discussion needs to be respectful.

- o PAL Basketball:
 - o New basketballs and uniforms (13) have been ordered and will be picked up next week.
 - o 143 players across 15 teams. Slightly down from last year.
 - o Practices begin at the end of October; games begin beginning of December.
- o Micro soccer: Looking for chair for April/2024.
- o Cheerleading: Chair vacancy/Look for spring.
- o Flag Football: No update. Will review program.
- o PAL Football:
 - o Good year with strong group of kids and parents.
 - o May review equipment by year-end to assess conditions.

- PAL Volleyball: Final tournaments are scheduled.
- PAL XC / Track:
 - Good season. Finished up 3rd to both girls and boys. XC is growing across PAL schools. Finished 17th with 1,200 kids.
 - March 15th is the start of track season for 6th, 7th and 8th graders.
- Micro basketball:
 - Finalizing registration – 105 kids.
 - 1st and 2nd grade will be separated boys and girls.
 - Start date is in November.
- CYSL Soccer: 1 week left on season.
- Baseball/Softball: EAA will open registration in November until January. Need to talk on field schedule and work with Marty.
- Tee ball: No report. Last year the program had 60 to 70 kids.
- Golf: Still planning on golf program.

New Topic:

Main coach (not assistants) will receive a 50% discount on registration fee for their own kids for that sport.
